Dr. Walid BEN HAMIDA is a Professor of Law at the University of Paris (France). He is a member of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) Arbitration Court. He served as arbitrator, expert and counsel. His practice focuses on Arab laws, international law, investor-state dispute settlement and arbitration.

Dr. BEN HAMIDA authored numerous publications on arbitration, ADR, dispute settlement and investment law, in the Arabic, French and English languages. He cooperates with many international organisations on issues of ADR, international trade, investment and Arab legal systems (World Bank, ESCWA, UNCTAD, Economic Commission for Africa). He is a regular speaker at conferences on arbitration and dispute settlement, and was visiting professor in more than 50 countries.
