Justice Torgbor is a specialist practising international arbitrator and mediator based in Nairobi with cases in Kenya, Uganda, Nigeria, France and England. He was formerly a practicing barrister in England and Judge of the High Court of Kenya. He is an Advocate of the Supreme Court of Zambia, Attorney at Law, Ghana, and Lecturer and Tutor in arbitration law and practice. He has published professional articles and is a Contributor to LCIA and Chartered Institute of Arbitrators' journals, Chairman, Participator and Presenter at numerous arbitration conferences, seminars and workshops in Kenya, Ghana, Nigeria, Uganda, Lesotho, South Africa, and England.

He was lead Counsel for the Eastern and Central African Trade Development Bank (PTA Bank) and Legal Consultant for UNEP and UN-Habitat. He drafted a Framework Environmental Law for the Kingdom of Cambodia and compiled a Compendium of Judicial Decisions on Environmental Law under UNEP Consultancy, and wrote a Guidebook on "The Right to Adequate Housing" for UN-Habitat.

He is a law graduate from the Universities of Edinburgh, Cambridge and Stellenbosch, with many years experience as Barrister in England, Judge in Kenya, and an International Arbitrator.
